Recently, the University of New Haven has subscribed to the Collaborative Institutional Training Initiative (CITI) of Miami.




• Go to: https://www.citiprogram.org

• Search for the University of New Haven as your affiliate program, then continue to the





• Select the appropriate learner program; i.e. Undergraduates choose: Group 6.




- Select the appropriate modules for your training

 - You may add more courses at any time by clicking "add a course" in the "my learner tools" navigation menu.






How to complete modules:
