

Victim Services

- 24/7 free and confidential sexual assault hotline
- Short term counseling for victims of sexual assault and their families
- Personal support and advocacy
- Accompaniment to the hospital, police department, and court
- Bilingual and male counselors available
- Referral network for long term professional counseling, legal assistance, and medical assistance
- University of New Haven college advocate and educator
- Support groups
- Multidisciplinary team response services for children ages 0-18, and accompaniment to forensic interviews at the South Central Child Advocacy Center

SEXUAL VIOLENCE DOES NOT DISCRIMINATE!

- 1 in 4 girls and 1 in 6 boys will experience sexual abuse by the age of 18
- Nearly half of all women, and 1 in 5 men have experienced some level of sexual assault in their lifetimes
- Every 2 minutes someone is sexually assaulted in the United States
