
THE FALL 2019 SEMESTER BEGINS!

Words of Wisdom from Kathy Kautz de Arango, our Executive Director


"Graduate students must always keep up a GPA of at least 3.0, and if after one semester (9 credits) your GPA is under 3.0, you will receive a notice. Undergraduates have a lower threshold, but still can fall out if they can't keep up their grades. Review the student handbook so you know what to do if your GPA slips.

I have observed over my 20 years in this field that many times for international students, academic struggles are more related to cultural adjustment because what is expected of them in the U.S. University is different than what is expected in their home culture. Your grades here will depend on class participation and team projects, as well as on exams and papers. Pay attention to the syllabus for each class and manage your time well."
